## Recognition of Students who Earned a Perfect Score

In October, we received the results of the Spring 2018 Ohio State Test and it is our pleasure to recognize the students who earned a perfect score in one or more areas of the test.

There were 42 students with a perfect score. Of those 42 students, we had the following repeats:

- One student, Maeva Lile, earned perfect scores this year in **two** areas—5<sup>th</sup> grade math and 5<sup>th</sup> grade science. In 2017, she earned a perfect score in 4<sup>th</sup> grade English Language Arts and, in 2016, she earned perfect scores in **two** areas—3<sup>rd</sup> grade ELA and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math.
- Milee Carillon earned a perfect score in 2018 in 4<sup>th</sup> grade math. In 2017, she also earned a perfect score in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math.
- Matthew Cymerman earned a perfect score in 2018 in 4<sup>th</sup> grade math. In 2017, he earned a perfect score in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math.
- Derek Steedley earned a perfect score in 2018 in 5<sup>th</sup> grade math. In 2017, he earned a perfect score in 4<sup>th</sup> grade math; and in 2016, he earned a perfect score in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math.
- Kenton Kern earned a perfect score in 2018 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade math; in 2017, he earned a perfect score in 5<sup>th</sup> grade social studies.

- David Bechtel earned a perfect score in 2018 in Algebra 1. In 2017, he earned a perfect score in 7<sup>th</sup> grade math; and in 2016, he earned a perfect score in 6<sup>th</sup> grade math.

These perfect scores did not happen by accident. It took a lot of hard work and studying on the part of the students; it took a lot of hard work on the part of their teachers; and, just as important, it took a lot of encouragement on the part of their parents. We would like to thank the parents for being a part of their children's education.
