Recognition of Students who Earned a Perfect Score

In October, we received the results of the Spring 2018 Ohio State Test and it is our pleasure to recognize the students who earned a perfect score in one or more areas of the test.

- Kenton Kern earned a perfect score in 2018 in 8th grade math; in 2017, he earned a perfect score in 5th grade social studies.

• David Bechtel earned a perfect score in 2018 in Algebra 1. In 2017, he earned a perfect score in 7th grade math; and in 2016, he earned a perfect score in 6th grade math.
