The McKinney-Vento Act supersedes conflicting state laws and local policies

Who is homeless?

(McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act of 2001 – Title X, Part C of the
No Child Left Behind Act – Sec 725)

The term “homeless children and youth” -

*(A) Means individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate
nighttime residence...; and*

(B) Includes -

- (i) children and youths who are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping groups due the lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; are abandoned in hospitals or are awaiting foster care placement;*
- (ii) children and youths who have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings...*
- (iii) children and youths who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus train stations, or similar settings; and*
- (iv) migratory children who qualify as homeless for the purposes of this subtitle because the children are living in circumstances described in clause (i) through (ii)*

Unaccompanied youth include young people who have run away from home, been thrown out of their homes, and/or been abandon by parents or guardians

The McKinney-Vento Act entitles students experiencing homelessness to:

- Immediate enrollment
- The ability to stay in school of origin
- Transportation services
- Title I
- Expedited assessment
- Free or reduced lunch
- Waived fees
- Educational and enrichment support
